**LENTEN REMINDERS:** Ash Wednesday, February 14, and Good Friday, March 30, are days of abstinence from meat and also of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (canons 97 and 1252). With regard to Good Friday, the teaching of the Second Vatican Council should be recalled. Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with uplifted and clear mind (Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110).

**OBLIGATION TO CONFESS SINS:** According to the Church's command, "after having attained the age of discretion, each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year." Anyone who is aware of having committed a mortal sin must not receive Holy Communion, even if he or she experiences deep contrition, without having first received sacramental absolution, unless he or she has a grave reason for receiving Communion and there is no possibility of going to confession. Children must go to the Sacrament of Penance before receiving Holy Communion for the first time.

**OBLIGATION TO RECEIVE HOLY EUCHARIST:** Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharistic Communion must be in the state of grace. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the Sacrament of Penance. The Church warmly recommends that the faithful receive Holy Communion each time they participate in the celebration of the Eucharist; she obliges them to do so at least once a year.

**TWINNING WITH PUERTO ESCONDIDO:** We had a great trip with lots accomplished. We left on Friday with the temperature at 86. We visited with different communities in the area. We met with the bishop who is very grateful for our presence and financial support. We celebrated his 5th anniversary as bishop. We met with the 25 seminarians. We prayed together, laughed together and ate together. We stopped in Mexico City and visited the basilica to Our Lady of Guadalupe and the cathedral where Bishop Zumarraga is buried. He is the first bishop of Mexico City and the one who met with Juan Diego.
